

SANTA FE INSTITUTE 2020 COMPLEX SYSTEMS SUMMER SCHOOL

THE PROGRAM

The SFI Complex Systems Summer School (CSSS) offers an intensive four-week introduction to complex behavior in mathematical, physical, living, and social systems. The program consists of a series of lectures, labs, and discussions focusing on foundational concepts, tools, and current topics in complexity science. The school is taught by the faculty of the Santa Fe Institute (SFI) and other leading educators and scholars. The program runs from June 14 to July 10, 2020.

ELIGIBILITY

The school is for graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, and professionals seeking to transcend traditional disciplinary boundaries, and take intellectual risks. Applicants are welcome from all countries. Women and members of underrepresented groups and institutions are especially encouraged to apply.
